## The King's Finger

ON BEING THE HANDS AND FEET OF GOD

Spring; a season of change. And there needs to be. If there were no change the death and dormancy of winter would not relent. We like the change that brings flowers and warmth. But we just as much need the change that goes the other way.

We don't like it, but liking it or not does not prevent it. So how can we find our way to rejoicing at the changes

in our lives, our world, and in creation? The change of Spring is a joyful reminder, maybe that can help us. When we see change in our children as they grow, or in our community as people come and go, and in our worldview as we grow in what we know, these can all be times of rejoicing. But harder still are those times of change that involve death and dying.

"Rejoice" may seem like too much to ask or expect at those times. But we still can. There is great comfort that can come from knowing there is no change that is outside of what is good and right about us and our world. There is no change that is not a

part of life. And there is no change that is beyond where God meets us. As hard as change is for us, we can find peace and

comfort, and may even rejoice, that God is just as much with us in the hard parts. The wisdom of Solomon is revealed in the poetry of Ecclesiastes, and is an amazing reminder of God's presence with us. The change of season is a good time to hear this reminder.

### VOLUNTEERS NEEDED AT THE VINEYARD CHURCH FOOD PANTRY

We are in need of someone who can help one of our volunteers once or twice a month with the food pick-up at the food pantry in Hillsboro on Thursdays from 8:30am till about 10:30am.

Job description:

+ Meet at PVC by 8am and ride out to food pantry with one of our volunteers.

+ Help load up food into the truck and bring it back to PVC.

+ Unload food into the pantry here at PVC.

+ Be able to lift 40 to 50 lb. boxes.

+ Have 2 to 2 1/2 hours once or twice a month to volunteer.

We are also in need of a volunteer who has a vehicle who would be willing to pick up food from Whole Foods in Hillsboro once or twice a month on Fridays. You can pick up as early as 8am, but no later than 9:30am.

+ If items need to be refrigerated must be willing to put them in the refrigerator.
