Starting off with some good news...we have an Interim Pastor starting Monday, December 1, 2014. Pastor Randy Sinn has been a pastor at Faith Lutheran Church of North Lakewood, Washington, for the past 25 years and decided earlier this year to make a change. This included moving to Oregon to be closer to his daughter and new grandson. While he is with us he will pick up all pastoral duties as well as lead us through the pastoral call process. Once we have called a new pastor he will move on to his next assignment. Mark on your calendars to be in church on December 6th to welcome Pastor Sinn.

Between now and December 1st supply pastors will continue to be leading services on Sunday and Pastor Dorothy Cottingham will continue to provide pastoral care as needed. I would like to take this time to congratulate the Nominating Committee: Roger Heikens, Gaynelle Dressel and Laurel Aszman, for their dedication to getting a representative slate of our membership on the ballot. Though they may not have a full slate at this moment they, and I, are confident they will by November 7. Please continue to support their important effort.

As required in our Constitution, our Annual Congregational Meeting will still be at the end of January where we will conduct our normal business.
