Calling a Pastor

FROM YOUR CHURCH COUNCIL

Hello to all the members of Christ the King Lutheran church. It has now been two weeks since Pastor Jeff Kallevig's last Sunday with us. It was quite a celebration and it was great to see so many familiar faces. Thanks so much for coming and making it such a wonderful event. Your continued support of the call process will also be needed to make it a success as well.

The last two Sundays we have been blessed to have our Sunday services lead by, first, Pastor Dorothy Cottingham, and most recently, Pastor Tom Struck. I am also looking for other Pastors of varying experience levels to lead us in worship so we can sample a variety of pastoral styles until our interim starts. Once our Interim Pastor is here we start the self-study process needed to complete the Ministry Site Profile document that will be our defining document to find the Pastor that best fits our Congregation.

In the meantime, there are questions to be asked and answered and the best place to ask is before or after church on Sunday. That is when you will get the most support. That is also the time you can provide the best support for other members during

this anxious time. If you have questions, please ask. There is no reason not to. Your Church Council wants you to be as informed and knowledgeable about the Call process as possible.

Your Church Council is working hard to settle on an Interim pastor. We have already met with a couple candidates and have a follow up meeting next week. This process is slow due to differing personal schedules, but we are working through as quickly as we can. Your Church Council is focused on getting a qualified Interim pastor to lead us through the call process.

The call process will not be difficult for us because we are a healthy congregation, but it will take time. Set your minds to calling someone by next summer. Between now and then there will be at least two additional Congregational meetings. One to elect the Call Committee and then some time next spring/summer to affirm the call of a new pastor.

Our monthly financial obligations will not change while we have an Interim. Pastors do not work for free just like you and I

do not or didn't. Not only must we continue our financial support of the church, but we must also continue to support each other.

The Call Committee will lead us through the CALL process. This is not a simple process, but will require the involvement of all members of CTK. Beginning with the important self-study, which then results in the Ministry Site Profile which will define our Pastoral needs and be a guide

for Synod to steer applicants to our Call Committee. A very important document.

Who can be an Interim Pastor?: Ordained Pastor's with years of experience and Interim training. Not all pastors have the skills or training to be an Interim. At the moment there are none available in the Oregon Synod.

Between now and the arrival of an interim pastor, Pastor Dorothy Cottingham has been contracted to provide our week day pastoral needs, visitations, etc. Please call Linda in the church office to schedule her time.

Questions about the interim process should be directed to the Call Committee or Church Council.

I think it is very important that we be here to support each other and talk about the Call process and the progress being

made. So let's make an effort to be available and supporting each other during this transition period.
