Grace to you and Peace from God our Father and the LORD Jesus Christ,

Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect.

Romans 12:2

Warren Schulz wrote an article on the "Theological Basis for Interim Ministry". His article is for both clergy and congregation. In his writing he uses three concepts that are related and connected, but that are not synonymous. These 3 words and his definitions are:

- Change:** the inevitable movement of life's forces
- Transition:** the process by which we must deal with the inevitable changes of life (the interim)
- Transformation:** the new shape that occurs after transition, toward which change is aimed

Let's get right to the heart of the matter, the heart of our Christian faith. God is always acting to *change* the horrible consequence of sin into forgiveness. 1 John 1:8-9 reminds us that we have all sinned and if we "say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us". So, God is acting to change us -- me!

The process of *transition* occurs as Jesus pours out his body & blood on a cross on Golgotha. God is working forgiveness in our transition into this new way of living, this "new kingdom living".

Easter morn, an empty tomb, and a joyous resurrection present a *transformation* to new life with a new shape. Thus, as Warren Schulz defines it for us, this is the goal toward which the change God has initiated for us is aimed. But, in God's infinite wisdom (or is it foolishness?) and trust, God leaves the shape of what this change looks like to be determined when we work together.

So, I would remind you that every day presents us with a transition into this transformed life. Indeed, the whole life of faith is one of continual transition into a transformed, resurrected life. This was true with the first disciples; it is still true for all disciples.

Transformation is not quick; it is not easy.

We have been working on transforming our community of faith, Christ the King Lutheran Church, to be the people God

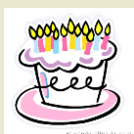

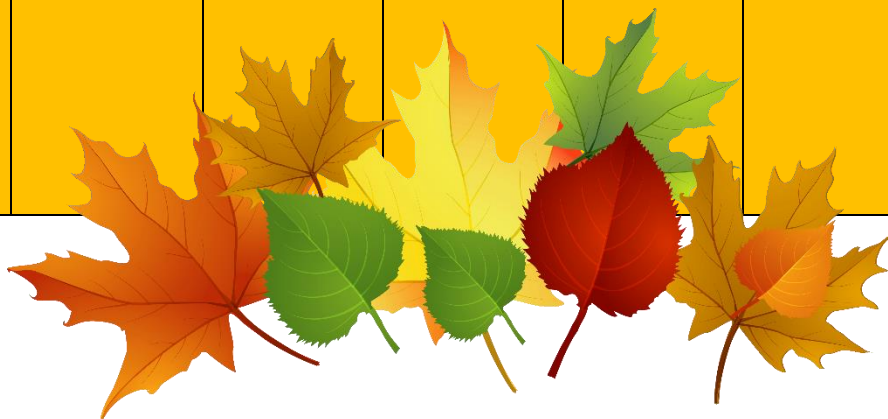
