I was devastated when I heard the news that my sister had died. On the 20-mile drive across town, I could scarcely see the road at times through my tears. In the midst of our grief, my two nieces and I tended to the immediate details. One called the pastor, the other called the funeral director and we shared the task of notifying our large extended family. I called each of my five brothers. I was surprised by their collective cavalier response "well, it's not like we didn't know this day was coming".

Jesus told the disciples, more than once, that he would be arrested, tried and put to death. He assured them that he would be raised from the dead on the third day. Yet, it was a shock to them when he was arrested. One of them turned him over to the authorities, one of them denied knowing him and the rest scattered into the night. The women stood vigil at the foot of the cross. A secret disciple, Joseph of Arimathea, took Jesus' body from the cross and laid it in a borrowed tomb while the women secretly watched.

When the Sabbath observance was ended, the women solemnly walked to the tomb. Their grief was so deep that they did not even consider how they would roll away the heavy boulder that blocked the entrance. Arriving just before dawn, they found the stone gone and the grave empty. Shock and fear replaced grief. The whole company of Jesus's followers locking themselves into a house or room where they huddled together, not knowing what to do.

We who stand on this side of the resurrection of Jesus the Christ find it easy to say "well, it's not like they didn't know this day was coming". It is easy to shake our heads at the disciples' seeming lack of understanding. After all, they had a distinct advantage over future believers. Jesus walked among them, taught them, told them what would happen, opened the

Scriptures to them and yet, they did not understand.

Easter! It is more than a one-day celebration. It is more than a 50-day season of the church year. It is our daily dying to sin and rising with Christ in the glory of God. There is a traditional hymn by John Bowring that says, "In the cross of Christ I glory, towering o'er the wrecks of time". Because of Christ's death on the cross and glorious resurrection we find "peace . . . that knows no measure, joys that through all time abide".

Knowing that her life on earth was coming to an end, my sister proclaimed with the confidence of a child of God, "I am not afraid to die, I know where I'm going...I will be with Jesus". Easter People, this is the promise of the resurrection: we are claimed by God because of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus the Christ. We know hope, for the Easter season but for eternity.



Lift your voice and shout with joy:

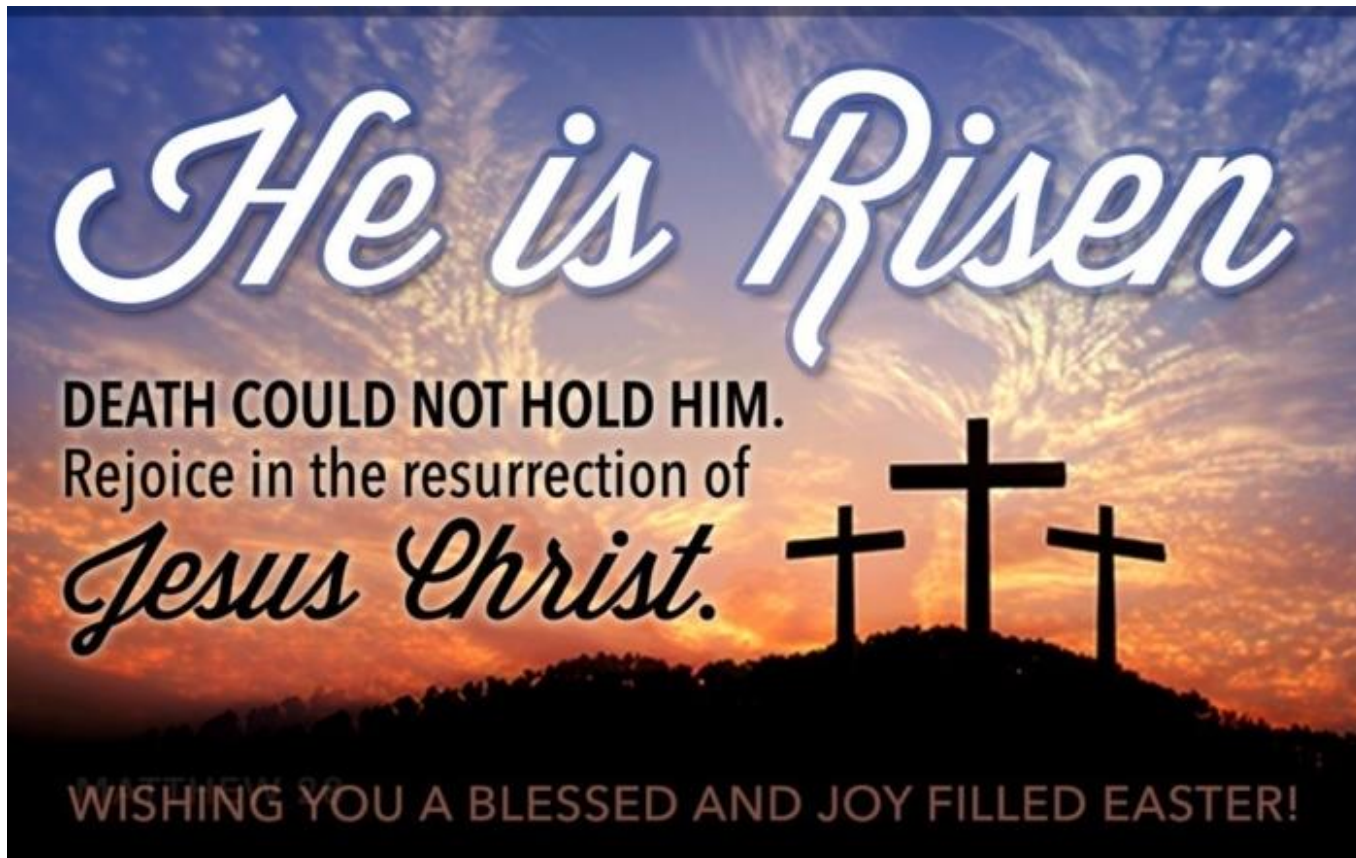
