
THANKSGIVING FOR BAPTISM


John 10:11-18

C Glory to you, O Lord.



I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. NICENE CREED

We believe in one God, the Father. the Almightv. maker of heaven and earth. of all that is, seen and unseen. 
