





By beginning the prayer this way, we remember that we belong to God, each other, and God's good creation. Using different names for God helps us remember God is bigger and more beautiful than we can imagine. Draw or write different names you know for God.



When God's kingdom is on earth as it is in heaven, it changes the world around us. People who have less power and money will get the rewards, care, love, and things they need. Everyone will have what they need to have full and healthy lives. Draw or write about "signs" you have seen of God's kingdom here on earth.



To have bread, it must be made. People use grain that grows from the earth to make bread. Daily bread can mean actual bread, food, or things we need to live full, healthy lives. When we pray for daily bread, we say "Yes" to partnering with God to make sure everyone has their daily bread. Draw or write about things you need to live a full, healthy life.



Debt is when we owe something—usually money—to someone else. When we have too much debt, it makes life very difficult. It also separates us from each other. When our debt is forgiven, we get a fresh start and are brought back to what was before.

Draw or write about how it feels to be welcomed back to something (or someone) you felt separated from.



Temptation is the desire to make a choice you know you shouldn't make. When we pray this, we are saying we will make decisions that bring God's love into the world by how we use our money, time, talents, skills, and other things God has given to us. Draw or write about how you choose to use these things God has given you.



We all have power. When we use our power in a bad way, that does violence. Violence and evil are actions that hurt and damage the life of something or someone. When we pray this, we trust that God's love will overcome and give us strength, love, and support when we feel evil has won. Draw or write about how you felt God near you during a difficult or scary time.



This last part of the prayer is a kind of declaration, a way to say "this is the way things need to be." When we say "amen" we promise to help make this prayer come true. Draw or write about how you can help this prayer come true.
